
## About the Foundation

## Next Generation Drivers

Distracted driving has become a roadway epidemic, with thousands of motorists killed or injured in the U.S. every year because of distracted driving crashes. At the Auto Club Group Traffic Safety Foundation, we're working to prevent distracted driving and other destructive driving behaviors, especially among young drivers.



Through our **Teen Driver Safety Program**, the Foundation deploys AAA

Driving Simulators throughout the states we serve. The simulator allows teen drivers to experience firsthand the dangers and consequences of distracted driving in a virtual setting.

The Foundation also works with high schools to teach young drivers about the deadly dangers of impaired driving. **AAA PROMise**, a program to protect teens and other drivers on the road during prom season, encourages students to abstain from alcohol/drugs and to never drink and drive.

## At Your Post—AAA School Safety Patrol

Since 1920, the **AAA School Safety Patrol™** program has created a safer environment for millions of children. Recognized as the largest traffic safety program in the world, it has been praised by safety and education groups around the globe for reducing injuries and deaths among 5- to 14-year-olds, the age group most at risk for pedestrian injury.



The Auto Club Group Traffic Safety Foundation administers the AAA School Safety Patrol™ program at thousands of schools by providing resources to run the program successfully. Students learn a sense of safety awareness, leadership skills and responsibility while proudly wearing their belts and badges as they work to keep students out of harm's way.

## Safety Through the Ages

Today's senior drivers are often healthy and active, but they are still at a greater risk of being killed or injured in a crash due to age-related fragility.

The Auto Club Group Traffic Safety Foundation utilizes programs such as **CarFit** and **AAA Roadwise Review** to ensure older drivers have the tools they need to stay safe on the road. CarFit offers seniors the opportunity to check how their cars "fit" them by leading them through a 12-point checklist with their vehicle, recommending adjustments to enhance comfort and safety behind the wheel. Through AAA Roadwise Review, seniors can measure the eight functional abilities shown to be the strongest predictors of crash risk among older drivers.
